ANNUAL REPORT 2015-16

The College, under the efforts taken by the Management, directions given by the Principal and suggestions put forth by IQAC, has initiated several efforts during the academic year 2015-16 and a snap shot of such steps is presented below:

- ❖ Departments, to understand where do they stand in terms of the seven criteria of NAAC, have been asked to self-evaluate themselves and come out with the score card using CGPA and methodology suggested by the accrediting agency. In a meeting, the HoDs were explained of the procedure for computing CGPA
- ❖ Training and Placement officer organized Career Guidance Programme to add to employment potential of the students
- ❖ Staff members have been motivated to apply for Major/Minor Research Project, which would help the institution to accelerate the pace of research activities
- ❖ Vocational Training Courses in the fields that ensure job have have been organized by Equal Opportunity Cell, the chief beneficiaries being girl students
- ❖ A National Level *Kavithai Payilarangam*(workshop) was organized by Department of Tamil. Further, the Department had also planned for a Book Release function
- ❖ Flood-lit Basket Ball Court was thrown open to the students. Being ultra-modern, several tournaments have been organized in the flood-lit ground
- ❖ Department-wise meetings were held by the Principal to review the progress and initiate activities to propel the progress in all the fields relevant to the departments
- ❖ Two new Post Graduate Programmes – M.Sc., Botany and M.Sc., Chemistry were started to Cater to the needs of students of graduating from basic sciences
- ❖ Library resources have been strengthened by subscribing to new journals

- ❖ Modernisation of several activities of Office of the Controller of Examinations took place. Printing student nominal roll, computation of CGPA and the like were computerised
- ❖ Three major projects and one minor project were in operation. The sum of the value of the projects amounted to Rs.18,40,000/-
- ❖ Around 140 papers were published in Peer Reviewed Journals
