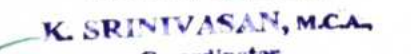

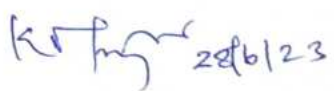
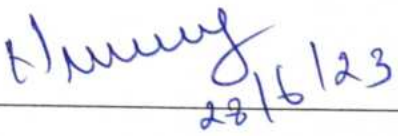
14.4.1 and 14.4.2: all the BOS members are accepted and suggested to follow the previous syllabus in addition to Naan Mudhalavan.
