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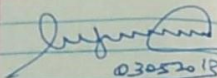
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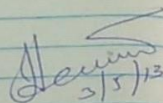

MINUTES

The Board of studies meeting for the academic year 2013-2014 commenced on the MIB department premises. Around 10.15 a.m, The chairman of the Board Mr. G. Vignesh, HOD of MIB introduced both the external and internal members.

Dr. K.S. Hema, University nominee, Mr. B. Saifudeen, H.D, Exim Shipping Services (I) Pvt Ltd, Industrial Expert, Dr. G. Chandrasekaran, Asst. prof and Head, Govt. Arts college, Coimbatore, Subject Expert. Mr. B. Jayakkumar, General Manager, Chandran Steels, Alumni member, were available along with the internal members. Ms. A. Kokila, Mr. N. Bhuvanesh Kumar and Ms. S. Pushpavathi.

As per the agenda the Board passed the syllabus for the I and II Semester for the students to be admitted in academic year 2013 and III and IV semesters for the students already admitted in the academic year 2013.

The Paper management process and practical proficiency in computers were excluded from the syllabus and Management for International Business and International Business relations are included in semester I. Statistical Techniques and operation research and Accounting for Decision Making papers are shifted vice versa in their respective semesters. International relation paper is excluded from the semester II and Paper computer application in business is shifted from semester I to semester II. Papers customs law and practice and Risk management and Insurance are interchanged in their respective semesters. International Human Resource Management is introduced in the III Semester and the specializations Government and Logistics are interchanged between the III and IV Semester. This is changed in accordance with the approval of the course teachers due to the content of the subjects were mismatching in their existing semesters.

Foreign exchange Management is deemed as elective paper in Semester III papers Sea Cargo and Air cargo management, security analysis and portfolio management have been removed. Export Import finance and logistics and freight management are new papers included in III and IV Semesters respectively. Meagre inputs were given to papers like foreign trade procedures and documentation, Foreign exchange management and logistics and freight management. The name of the paper Industrial training is changed as Inplant training.

Both internal and external members were happy in conducting the BOS 2013-14 and the chairman have also shared an idea to introduce some new papers in the forthcoming Bos.

The official closure of Bos was made around 2:00pm by the chairman.
