Q.No. 11-15 : Either (a) Or (b) pattern.

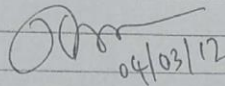
Section-C $4 \times 10 = 40$ Marks.

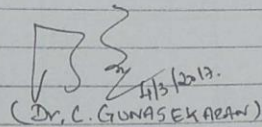
