PG and Research Department of Botany

The library facilities may be improved by providing more e- journals and research newsletters subscribed and purchase of some important books on life sciences so the students can update the knowledge in research. Our college is providing good area of research environment to both staffs and students and it was strongly agreed by our staffs and they suggested to provide the sophisticated instruments such as LCMS/MS, GCMS, FTIR, SEM and etc. to take off the research to next level and also this may help to get more funding from external agency viz., DBT, DST, MoENF etc. All our staffs agreed that infrastructure is good and competent and they suggested providing fresh water ponds, herbal garden, glass houses, green houses etc., separately vision of NAAC.
