From the feedback collected from 2014-2017, passed out batch alumni (Collected during the year 2018) the following results have come up:

1. Admission Procedure

About 78% of alumni have stated that the admission procedure for their course in the college is very good, while the remaining 22% have stated that it is good.

2. Relevance of Curriculum for their Job

There are about 10% of alumni have opined that the relevance of curriculum for their job is very good, and the remaining (i.e) the majority 90% have opined that it is good.

13. Sport Activities

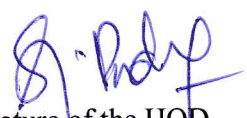
The majority of alumni (i.e) 45% have stated that the sport activities are good and the remaining 22% have stated that they are very good.

60% of faculty have agreed and 40% have strongly agreed on this aspect.

Majority (i.e) 60% of faculty have agreed on this aspect and the remaining 40% have strongly agreed.

60% of faculty have strongly agreed that the college evinces interest in institutional/social responsibilities and the remaining 40% have agreed on it.

32. Fee concession for staff members for doing M.Phil/ Ph.D. is sufficient:

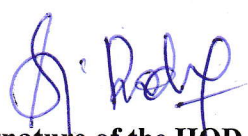
100% of faculty have agreed on this aspect.

IV. Personality Development

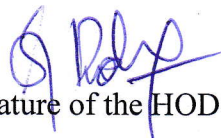
53 % of parents are highly satisfied about the personality development, while the remaining 47% have stated that it is satisfactory.
