In Global Financial Management include derivatives, in International Economics Change the title of the II unit as BOP and Exchange Rate Policy (Subject Expert).

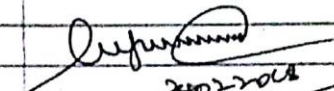
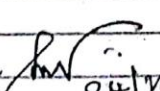
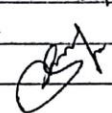
Map Reading and Documentation filling paper shall be revamped by introducing current documentation and to eliminate unused/old documents (Industrial Expert).

Based on University Representative's suggestions, the following changes can be done. - At least twenty percentage of syllabus content should use MOOC (Massive open online Courses) - Feedback should be obtained from stakeholders and then based on the feedback only syllabus should be framed. - Courses should be in such a way to increase the employability, leadership and skill development. - E-Books, E-modules, NPTEL videos for course content should be mentioned in the syllabus itself. - A separate course of internship training program is to be incorporated in the curriculum. - Suggested to offer value added course for life skills development. - In 1st sem. Instead of cryptography & network security paper, Information Security paper introduced. Based on Industrial Experts suggestions, the following changes can be done. - In third semester, RDBMS & Java [framed] lab paper can be changed to RDBMS lab. - In third semester, HTML & JSP lab can be changed into HTML & CSS [responsive design] - In fourth semester, C# new prog. lab paper's title can be renamed as Scripting programming or Visual programming. - In fifth semester, Major Section I paper Data Mining & Analytics can be changed and Data Analytics can be introduced based on industrial need. In sixth semester, Major Section III Multimedia technologies paper is outdated & so it can be changed.

Based on Subject Matter and Academic Aspects:

Suggestions for following changes must be made

1. A better paper can be chosen by few departments and provide subject paper options for the students.

2. Support in not lecture material can be used to enhance the students learning activities in class room outside the program time.

3. Detailed subject material is given.

4. Based on literature suggestions, the format changes can be made.

1. Reference can be given to papers like Anticipated, Information, Long term, and computing, etc. based on industrial need.

2. Topics can be invited to give a session on latest concepts.

3. Projects should be more practical oriented and it can be done in group.

4. Still hand paper based on latest industry needs should be introduced.

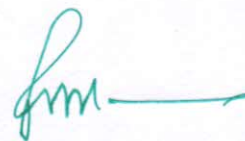
