Vice – Chancellor, Alagappa University, Karaikudi

Professor N. Rajendran is currently the Vice-Chancellor of Alagappa University, Karaikudi. He is having 34 years of teaching experience. He has been entrusted with the task of founding new departments at Bharathidasan University. He had been the Founder Professor of History, Founder Director of Bharathidasan School of Management (2016-2017) and Founder Director of Centre for Social Exclusion and Inclusive Studies (2007-2008). He also served as the Director for Centre for Distance Education (Bharathidasan University - 2014 -15). He served as Dean, Faculty of Arts for two terms (2008 to 2015). Besides, he was also the Co-ordinator for RUSA scheme from 2014 to 2016.

In his acclaimed academic career, Professor N. Rajendran has received many academic accolades and awards. He had been honoured with the prestigious Membership (one among 18 historians all over India) in the Indian Council of Historical Research, Ministry of Human Resource Development, Government of India, New Delhi, from 2008 to 2015. He had been UGC review committee member for Centre for Advance Studies (CAS) scheme for University of Calcutta, Kolkata – 2008 – 2013 and UGC review committee member for Centre for Advanced Studies (CAS) scheme for Centre for Historical Studies, Jawaharlal Nehru University, New Delhi- 2016 – 2021.

He served as the General Secretary of the Tamil Nadu History Congress for 10 years from 2007 to 2017. Concurrently, he had been the General Secretary of the South Indian History Congress from 2015 to 2017. Prof. N. Rajendran is the only academician to hold the position of General Secretary of two premier history associations simultaneously.

He has produced more than 20 Ph.D. scholars and more than 100 M.Phil. Scholars. He has published 65 research articles in various national and international peer reviewed journals of reputation including EPW and Sage Publication journals. He has contributed academic articles in The Hindu, Indian Express and Frontline.

As an eminent historian and a prolific writer, he has published and edited 12 books. National Movement in Tamil Nadu: Agitational Politics and State Coercion, 1905-1914, published by the Oxford University Press, 1994, is a unique research book, and a magnum opus of all his writings, in which he has challenged the very thesis and ideas of the Cambridge historians. He has been honoured with the "Citation of Meritorious Achievement" from the Cambridge University. Besides, he received the Best Tamil Book Award and honoured with the title "Sindanai Peroli" for his book Tamil Natil Desiyam and Swadesiyam (Tamil) in 2003. He served as the Coordinator of Dictionary of Martyrs: India's Freedom Struggle (1857-1947), Southern Region, an ICHR project.

Prof. N. Rajendran has delivered 170 lectures as a resource person and invited speaker for academic programmes, including UGC Refresher and Orientation courses, Training Programmes and Endowment Lectures. He has presented 162 research papers in various national and international seminars, workshops, symposiums and conferences.

He has been instrumental in shaping the curriculum of a number of universities and colleges by serving as a Member of Research Board of various universities of Tamil Nadu such as Bharathidasan University, Tiruchirappalli, Periyar University, Salem, Thiruvalluvar University, Vellore and Tamil Nadu Open University, Chennai as well as Member in Board of Studies in various colleges and Universities across India. He also served as a member of IQAC and Coordinator for Social Sciences during NAAC reaccreditation at Bharathidasan University.

He has successfully organised 10 UGC Refresher Courses and more than 65 national and international level conferences and seminars, sponsored by UGC, ICHR and TANSCH.

With his academic credibility and administrative ability, he has provided clean and transparent administration as an academic administrator in every position he has occupied so far, which has been highly appreciated by the academia.
