ANNUAL REPORT 2017-2018

Time table format was changed for both Internal and External Examinations. To make the candidates understand explicitly the date and time of the examination, time table was generated in the form of columns and rows. Another innovative change made in the Arrears Time-table was to print the students register number in the time table itself.

Hall tickets and Mark Sheets were issued with students' photographs printed. All examinations related information are published in our college website including time table, examination results and dates of the issuance of hall-tickets.

During the Odd Semester the Pre-Model Test commenced on 21st August 2017 and ended on 28th August 2017. Model Test started on 25th October 2017 and ended on 30th October 2017.

After the Continuous Internal Assessment Programme was conducted, Internal OMR sheets were collected from each department. The End Semester examinations commenced on 8th November 2017 and ended on 27th November 2017. Central Valuation was simultaneously held while the written examinations were going on. External OMR Sheets were generated, distributed and collected from the examiners. The Passing Board was conducted on 4th January 2018 and the results were uploaded at our College Website.

During the Even Semester the Pre-Model Test was conducted from 12th February 2018 to 16th February 2018. Similarly Model Test started on 12th April 2018 and ended on 18th April 2018. End-of-Semester Examinations commenced on April 27th 2018 and ended on 15th May 2018. After the Central and Door Valuation the Passing Board was held on 28th May 2018 and the results were published and uploaded at NGM website. Number of students appeared in the Examinations conducted by the institution year wise was 5284.

The total number of students appeared was 1741 and the number of students passed was 1399. The pass percentage was 80.35%.

During the Odd semester the number of applications received for revaluation was 55 and the number of revaluation cases marks changed was 51. The total percentage was 92.7.

During the Even Semester the number of applications received for revaluation was 54 and the number of revaluation cases marks changed was 54. The total percentage was 100.



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ANNUAL REPORT 2016-2017

With an objective of enhancing the standard of curriculum, Academic Audit had been carried out before the Board of Studies was conducted. Previous year syllabus from each programme was depatched to the Auditors concerned and sought his valuable advice to scrutinize whether the syllabus prescribed was upto the mark. The same auditor was invited to attend the current Board of Studies and ascertain the merits and demerits of the previous as well as the current syllabi.

Another important feature which was implemented during this year was the implementation of scrutinizing the End-of-Semester Question papers, which resulted in verifying whether the question papers were free from grammatical and typographical errors and to ensure whether the question papers were set as per the syllabus prescribed.

Similarly in the Continuous Internal Assessment Tests and End-of Semester Examinations, the pattern of the question was changed. Question-number 16 in Section C is made mandatory with an aim of focusing on the analytical skill of the candidates. This specific question is to be set from one of the five Units of the syllabus.

During the odd semester the Pre-Model Test started on 29th August 2016 and ended on 2nd September 2016. The Model Test commenced on 26th October 2016 and ended on 2nd November 2016.

After conducting the Pre-Model and Model tests, time-table was generated and the End-of Semester Examinations started on 10th November 2016 and ended on 28th November 2016. Passing Board was conducted on 22nd February 2017 and the results were uploaded at NGM College Website.

During the Even Semester the Pre-Model Test Commenced on 13th February 2017 and ended on 17th February 2017. The Model Test started on 17th April 2017 and ended on 21st April 2017.

Similarly for the End of Semester Examinations of May 2017, the examinations started on 4th May 2017 and ended on 20th May 2017. Passing Board was conducted on 31st May 2017 and the results were uploaded at our College Website. The results were passed within 11 days from the end of the End Semester Examinations. This was possible thanks to the efforts made by the Office of the Controller of Examination as Central Valuation was simultaneously conducted when the written examinations were going on. Moreover so far Door Valuation was conducted for Part-IV but from this year onwards it was converted into Central Valuation. Number of students appeared in the Examinations conducted by the institution year wise was 5048.

Total number of students appeared was 1767 and the number of students passed was 1639. The Pass percentage was 92.75.

During the Odd semester the number of applications received for revaluation was 69 and the number of revaluation cases marks changed was 64. The total percentage was 92.7.

During the Even Semester the number of applications received for revaluation was 23 and the number of revaluation cases marks changed was 23. The percentage was 100.

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ANNUAL REPORT 2015 - 2016

In the Examination cell automation, the introduction of Optical Marks Reader software made the task of checking the result copies easier. After circulating the time-table Pre-Model and Model tests were conducted. Then the Internal OMR sheets were generated and issued to the departments. The External OMR sheets were also generated at the time of the examination after generating dummy numbers after leaving the absentees through examination hall attendance.

During the odd semester the Pre-Model Test started on 31st August 2015 and ended on 4th September 2015. The Model Test commenced on 27th October 2015 and ended on 2nd November 2015.

For the End of Semester Examinations time-table was generated and hall tickets were issued to the candidates. The Semester Examinations commenced on 12th November 2015 and ended on 30th November 2015. Central Valuation was conducted for Part-I, II and III courses in our College premises and the Door valuation was arranged for Part-IV courses. Passing board was conducted on 20th February 2016 and the results were uploaded at NGM College Website on that date itself.

The time-table for both the Odd and Even semesters of Pre-Model test and Model test was prepared and the Tests were conducted as scheduled earlier. During the Even Semester the Pre-Model Test commenced on 10th February 2016 and ended on 16th February 2016. The model Test started on 7th April 2016 and ended on 15th April 2016. Similarly the time-table for End of Semester Examinations was generated and issued to the Departments concerned. The End of Semester Examinations started on 27th April 2016 and ended on 13th May 2016. Central valuation and Door valuation were conducted and the passing board was conducted on 9th June 2016 and the results were uploaded at NGM Website. Number of students appeared in the Examinations conducted by the institution year wise was 4932. Total number of students appeared was 1671 and the number of students passed was 1397. The pass percentage was 83.60.

During the Odd semester the number of applications received for revaluation was 45 and the number of revaluation cases marks changed was 45. The total percentage was 100.

During the Even Semester the number of applications received for revaluation was 69 and the number of revaluation cases marks changed was 68. The total percentage was 98.5.

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ANNUAL REPORT 2014 – 2015

To upgrade the Examination cell automation, Optical Marks Reader (OMR) Software was introduced from 2014 Batch of students. Internal OMR sheets and External OMR sheets were printed. For the Continuous Assessment Programme Internal marks were entered in the Internal OMR sheets. End of Semester marks were entered in the External OMR sheets. With the introduction of OMR technology, publication of results was expedited. The External OMR sheets were generated at the time of examinations after generating dummy numbers after eliminating absentees through examination hall attendance OMR reading.

The timetable for the CIA programmes was distributed to all the departments and the Pre-Model and Model tests were conducted. During the Odd semester, the Pre-Model Test started on 25th August 2014 and ended on 1st September 2014. The Model Test commenced on 27th October 2014 and ended on 31st October 2014. Similarly the timetable for the End of Semester Examinations was issued and the Semester Exams were scheduled to start on 10th November 2014 and ended on 27th November 2014.

After generating the Internal OMR sheets, they were issued to all the departments to enter the Internal marks. The External OMR sheets were generated after eliminating the absentees through exam hall attendance OMR reading. The answer scripts were valued through Central Valuation at our College premises and the passing board was conducted on 20th January 2015. The mark sheets were generated after the moderation. Revised mark sheets were issued to those students who had applied for revaluation.

During the Even semester the Pre-Model Test commenced on 9th February 2015 and ended on 13th February 2015. Model Test commenced on 6th April 2015 and ended on 10th April 2015. For the April 2016 End of Semester Examinations, the Internal and External OMR sheets were prepared through software. The April 2015 End of Semester Examinations commenced on 24th April 2015 and ended on 14th May 2015 and after the central and door valuation, the passing board was held on 11th June 2015 and the results were published and uploaded at NGM Website. Number of students appeared in the Examinations conducted by the institution year wise was 4787. Total number of students appeared was 1609 and the number of students passed was 1367. The pass percentage was 84.96.

During the Odd semester the number of applications received for revaluation was 29 and the number of revaluation cases marks changed was 27. The total percentage was 93.1. During the Even semester the number of applications received for revaluation was 15 and the number of revaluation cases marks changed was 13. The total percentage was 86.66.

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ANNUAL REPORT 2013 – 2014

The examination cell furnished the Academic Calendar for 2013 and 2014 detailing all the dates of Pre-Model Test and Model Test, the commencement and end of the End-of- Semester Examinations, issue of ESE Application forms for UG and PG, ESE fees collection, Board of Studies Meeting, Standing Committee of the Academic council, Academic Council Meeting, Central Valuation and the publication of results.

The time-table for the Pre-Model Test and Model Test and End-of-Semester Examinations was prepared through software, printed and issued to the departments. Practical Examinations were conducted for the departments concerned. Pre-model test commenced on 2nd September 2013 and ended on 6th September 2013. Model Test commenced on 26th October 2013 and ended on 31st October 2013. The End-of-Semester Examinations commenced from 11th November 2013 and ended on 29th November 2013. The dummy numbers were generated through the software and the answer scripts were affixed with dummy numbers. The entire process was checked.

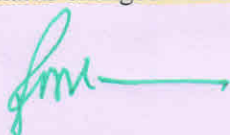
Both the Internal and External examiners were informed to attend the central valuation at our College premises and the passing board was conducted on 18th January 2014. For Parts I, II and III central valuation was conducted whereas for Part –IV Door valuation was arranged. Passing Board was conducted on 18th January 2014. The mark sheets were generated through automation and distributed to the students.

Revaluation was conducted for those students who applied for the same and the modified marks were incorporated in the mark sheets. Candidates who failed during the odd semester appeared for the Arrear Examinations in the month of February 2014. During the even semester Pre-Model Test commenced on 12th February 2014 and ended on 17th February 2014. Model Test commenced on 7th April and ended on 11th April 2014. The April 2014 Semester Examinations were planned in advance and the End-of-Semester Examinations started on 28th April 2014 and ended on 17th May 2014 and the results were published on 16th June 2014.

Number of students appeared in the Examinations conducted by the institution year wise was 4539.

Total number of students appeared was 1474 and the number of students passed was 1277. The overall pass percentage was 86.63.

During the Odd semester the number of applications received for revaluation was 21 and the number of revaluation cases marks changed was 21. The total percentage was 100. Similarly during the Even semester the number of applications received for revaluation was 34 and the number of revaluation cases marks changed was 33. The total percentage was 97.


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
