2. Detailed Report (Include Nature , Impact and Scope of the Programme)

Report on India for Tigers “Rally on wheels” in commemoration of 75th anniversary of Indian Independence – Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav organised by Anamalai Tiger Reserve Department of Zoology, Department of Botany and Department of Physical education.

In connection with the project Tiger scheme and to celebrate the 75th anniversary of Indian Independence – Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav has been celebrated on September 30, 2021 with the inauguration of a bicycle and vehicle rally has been arranged in the name of India for Tigers "Rally on wheels" and with a tree plantation program by the Tamilnadu State Forest Department, Anamalai Tiger Reserve, Pollachi, Department of Zoology, Department of Botany and Department of Physical Education.

The event started at 9.30 am in Arutchelvar Arangam, NGM College campus. The program has inaugurated in the august presence of Sub-collector Pollachi, Mr. Thakare Shubham Dnyandeorao I.A.S., Thiru. N.S. Murali IFS, Inspector General of Forests, National Tiger Conservation Authority, southern region Bangaluru, Mr. S. Ramasubramaniam, DFO, Dr. C. Manickchezian, Principal i/c, NGM College, Pollachi, Mr. S.N. Thejasvi, DFO, Mr. K. Ganeshram, ACF & AD, Udumalpet.

The function started with a grand rally organised by Lions Club – Prince, Pollachi followed by an inaugural session that started with Tamil Thai Vaazhthu and a welcome address by Mr. S. Ramasubramaniam IFS. He insisted on the importance of this event, the saving of tiger project, and role of tiger reserves, followed by Thiru. N.S. Murali IFS gave a special address on Tigers and their role in a healthy forest ecosystem and statistical data on tiger population increase. He expressed that the tiger is one of the representations of a healthy ecosystem. Dr. C. Manickachezian gave an informative speech on Tigers about their features, characters, and habits. He also insisted on the importance of the food chain and the food web for a healthy ecosystem. The certificate and memento were distributed to all dignitaries, forest officials for their effective work on tiger conservation, and the organisers of this event. There was a cultural event organised by the NGM College sports students insisting on the importance of tree conservation and the role of the forest department in conserving the ecosystem. Finally, the meeting ended with a vote of thanks and the National Anthem. The programme is an outreach and awareness programme as mentioned by NAAC criterion No. 3.6.3. for the benefit of students and the public in creating environmental awareness and understanding the importance of forests. The function was conducted in a well defined manner with all protocols as prescribed by the Government of India and Government of Tamilnadu. The seating arrangements are made accordingly by having social distancing strictly enforced, and only limited students are allowed to participate. The programme is very successful.
