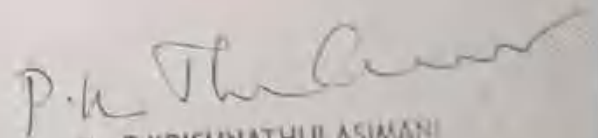
Programme: “Workshop on Agripreneurship Skill Development Programme”

good pace and already 14 **Standing Committees have been formed.**

MGNCRE's Desire has met with Design for working effectively. Vice Chancellors, Directors, Heads of Institutions and Key stakeholders actively participated in our programs and gave instructions for the furtherance of the program objectives. Formation of Cells in HEIs and Mentee Institutions was a cumulative effort of engaging identified Swachhta Ranked HEIs. Workshops were on implementing vocational activity, self-reliance, Swachhta, health and community engagement.

Recognition Certificates were issued to the Institutions for fulfilling the norms of being a successful Action Plan Institution. These institutions become eligible for competitions at Institution level, District level and at Cluster level. The Best Action/Business Plan entries will be showcased at Regional and National Conferences. The students who participated in the activity and successfully implemented the action/business will be recognized as the Brand Ambassadors from their respective institutions. These students will also get an opportunity to work with MGNCRE on a voluntary basis.

Action Research Projects were conducted in Vocational Education, Social Entrepreneurship and Rural Entrepreneurship. The Action Research Projects include - action to implement the planned improvement; monitor and describe the effects of the action; evaluate the outcomes of the action; and plan an improvement in practice. Introductory workshops on 4 aspects of Swachhta state wise were conducted and the areas of knowledge sharing included aspects of Swachhta in Campus; Campus Jal Shakti

(Water Conversation in campus); and Campus-Post Covid 19 Sanitation Plan. Consequently 1843 Swachhta Action Plan Committees were formed.

As part of its capacity building initiative, MGNCRE networked with HEIs in order to develop synergic convergence of human resources which are socially and economically just and inclusive for the vulnerable sections of rural India. We very well connected the linkages of Work and Education. Rural Management course was propagated as an employment opportunity available in rural management sector. Efforts led to formation of Entrepreneurship Cells in HEIs. There is a need for Rural Management professionals for the country's growth.

Ensuring effective communication with the team members was a major challenge. It is heartening that the world is going through a resilience and MGNCRE is part of this. 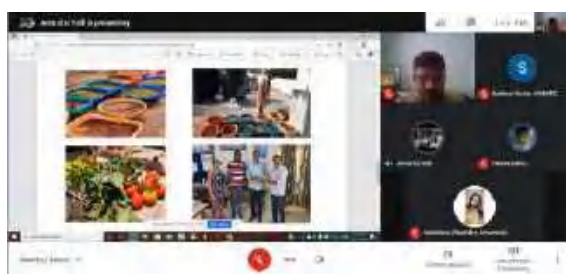

Case Discussion Methodology on Rural Management and Rural Entrepreneurship

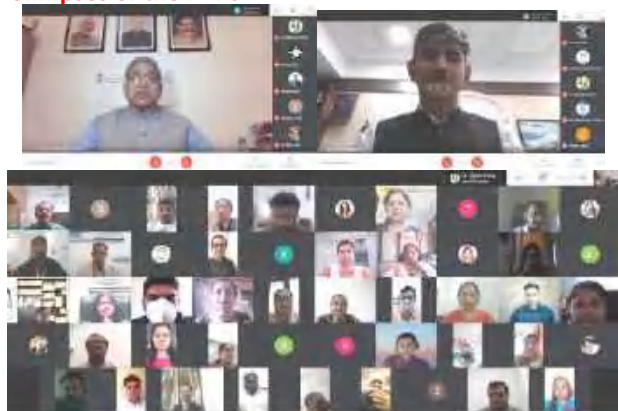
Two 5-day Faculty Development Programmes on Case Discussion Methodology were held for management faculty during 23rd – 27th March by FDC MGNCRE -

Case discussion methodology is an instructional method (not a theory) that refers to assigned scenarios based on situations in which students observe, analyze, record, implement, conclude, summarize, or recommend. Case studies are created and used as a tool for analysis and discussion.

The FDP Impact –In continuation of FDP on Case Discussion Methodology organised by MGNCRE, faculty members have started implementing the case discussion methodology in their respective institutions.

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Report

Title: “Skill Mastery Workshop”

Date: 5th March, 2021.

Preamble: A One day Workshop on General Analytical Skills and Computational

Chemistry has been conducted by The Department of Chemistry,
NallamuthuGounderMahalingam College, Pollachi, on 5th March, 2021 in the interest of imparting the importance of analytical skills, an essential part of science education and the superficial knowledge on computational chemistry.

Participants Details:

A total of 140 students from two different institutions namely, NallamuthuGounderMahalingam College, Pollachi, Coimbatore District (UG Chemistry students) and Sri Paramakalyani College, Alwarkurichi, Tirunelveli District (PG Chemistry Students) were benefited.

Description of the Workshop:

In his presidential address, Dr. P.M. Palanisamy, Principal, NallamuthuGounderMahalingam College, Pollachi, emphasized the importance of practical skills in science education and the need for computational knowledge in this prevailing situation. In the first session, Dr.S.JannathulFirdhouse, Assistant Professor, Department of Chemistry, HajeeKaruthaRowtherHowdia College, Uthamapalayam, spoke about various analytical techniques exploited in chemical analysis, their importance, and the job opportunities for analytical chemist's. In the second session, Dr.S.Gandhimathi, Assistant Professor and Head, Department of Chemistry, Sri Paramakalyani College, Alwarkurichi, has introduced the concept of molecular editors and demonstrated in detail the features of Chem Draw, a molecular editor. She also explained how to get chemical structures, their names, etc., by employing the drawing software.

The entire programme was co-ordinated with the support of the Principal, Head, faculty and Ph.D research scholars of the department of Chemistry, Nallamuthu Gounder Mahalingam College, Pollachi.

Feedback:
