Simply put 'Freebies' are public welfare measures – goods or services – offered free of cost by the government. As far as the Indian context is concerned, freebies are not precisely defined in the legal framework. As of now it is used as a political term by the Central Government to express its disapproval of certain schemes at the state-level. It is highly likely that the meaning will change as time evolves. Now it must be noted that certain expenditures done under populist pressures are questionable to say the least, but given the astronomical rise of income inequality among the Indian populace, some of these freebies may be justified in order to put the economy on its right track.

Empowering Rural Women

The Tamil Nadu government's primary objective for this program was to enable women, particularly in the rural areas, to acquire knowledge for social and economic development. From these research findings, it can very well be argued that this unique non-traditional strategy of the Tamil Nadu government was one of the most effective, targeted interventions of the Dravidian administration to uplift and empower women. Historically, the Justice Party, precursor to the DMK, played a big role in women's empowerment. as free mid-day meal scheme, free bus pass, free cycles and free laptops- and affirmative actions- including both horizontal and vertical reservations. Along with free colour TV, schemes to remunerate women graduates among others have paid huge dividends in the attainment of the educational goals of women.

Review of Literature

Ramesh Pandita¹ (2022) in his article entitles "Politics of Freebies" had stated that Strange it may sound but the fact it remains that people riding the costliest cars, living lavish & dignified lifestyles, owning millions and billions of rupees have actually been reduced to be labelled as beggars by their own Chief Minster for supporting his freebie politics and are shamelessly happy to receive a meager Rs 300/- or so a month as waiver on their electricity and water bills. Nipun² (2020) in his report "Freebies Culture In Indian Politics", had concluded that freebie schemes must be used for individuals who are in desperate need of basic necessities. It must not be used by political parties in a way that lowers election competition between them. Elections must be held in a free and fair manner in order to benefit society and to assist the needy. Saksham Vashishtha³ (2023), in his article entitled "The Role of Freebies in Indian Politics", had punted out that freebie schemes are the social welfare regimes whereby material goods are distributed to the poor and vulnerable populations of the country and he;ping their uplift their socio-economic condition. According to the conclusion of Kuunal Bakshi & Shreva⁴ (2023), "A Critical Analysis of Distribution of Election Freebies" Freebies in general is bribery Not just the cash- from laptops to cows to mixes grinders to all sort other goodies, political parties of all ilk, belief and ethics have infused a draconian culture in the Indian democracy, a culture where freebies has been not used as a tool to cure the social apathy, but conducted to create financial gains, private assets and to achieve major vote pluralities.

Tamil Nadu State Government is offered a number of Freebies schemes to the people for socially and economically empowering of rural women. There have been studies which showed the poverty-reducing effect of the Public distribution System. The free or subsidized rations under PDS allows food grains to be available for cheap for consumers while assuring remunerative prices to farmers. Subsidized food grains distributed under the PDS contribute to ensuring basic food security. The Pradhan Mantri Garib Kalyan Anna Yojana (PMGKAY) kept many away from the brink of starvation during the novel corona virus pandemic. Mid-day meals in schools have been proven to contribute to increased enrolment and retention in schools and addresses classroom hunger. It also resulted in keeping the evil of child labour under control. Tamil Nadu government's free bus pass for women has encouraged more women to join the workforce, in turn leading to economically stable families and women's empowerment. The introduction of free colour television in villages has resulted in decrease in domestic violence and also enabled women's empowerment as women have been able to connect with the outside world through visual media. It has ensured self-respect, as women and children are able to watch TV in their houses rather than visit the homes of those who are rich and own TV sets. Subsidies such as free laptops have now become necessities for increasing productivity, knowledge and skills. The small amounts given to the poor are called 'freebies', while freebies that the rich get through low tax rates and exemptions are referred as 'incentives'. Fiscal incentives are given to encourage corporate/entrepreneurs to boost industrial growth.

Statement of the Problem

Because the country's education system is deteriorating, the majority of people are in favor of improving and concentrating on education. Therefore, the state government has taken steps to improve education, and one of the steps in helping the education system is launching the Pudhumai Penn Scheme. This initiative also prioritizes the education of female residents. Mr. Stalin established the Moovalur Ramamirtham Ammayar memorial 'Puthumai Penn' (Modern Woman) Scheme, which stipulated that female students who attended government schools from grades 6 to 12 and were interested in pursuing higher education were eligible to receive a monthly stipend of 1,000 rupees. Further, lack of education, insufficient of water resources, transport cost, Unemployment, lack of income, poverty and lack of financial supports are the major constraints to the people especially in rural India. Hence, urgently need to undertake this study in order to know various schemes like offered by Tamil Nadu State Government for the welfare of the rural people in the study area.

Tamil Nadu Chief Minister M.K. Stalin inaugurated **'Pudhumai Penn'** on September 5 in Chennai. Delhi Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal was there. In Chennai, Bharathi Women's College had an event. During the ceremony, Mr. Kejriwal presented 26 schools of excellence and 15 model schools established by the Tamil Nadu government in imitation of his AAP administration in Delhi.

Naan Mudhalvan program,

Under the 'Naan Mudhalvan program, the Tamil Nadu Skill Development Corporation (TNSDC) will offer courses to government college students in Tamil Nadu on drones, 5G, and ChatGPT. Approximately 4,767 students have already signed up for Chat GPT for the upcoming semester, while 3,600 have chosen to participate in drone testing and design sessions, according to J. Innocent Divya, the managing director of Tamil Nadu Skill Development Corporation (TNSDC). Pudhumai Penn Scheme

Chief Minister M.K. Stalin will inaugurate the **Pudhumai Penn Scheme** in Chennai in the presence of Delhi's CM Arvind Kejriwal. Under "Pudhumai Penn,' all female students from Classes 6 to 12 in government schools will be paid 1,000 a month till they finish their undergraduate degree, diploma, or ITI. Their bank account will be credited. Students may get various scholarships. This plan aims to encourage higher education among economically disadvantaged females. Additionally, 6 million females will benefit annually from this plan. The initiative was budgeted for 698 crores in 2022-23. M.K Stalin and Arvind Kejriwal inaugurated a social welfare initiative and model school scheme in Tamil Nadu. The program would provide monetary assistance to students who are enrolled in educational institutions who fulfill the norm requirements. In addition, this program is

geared toward improving the general well-being of female students and encouraging them to continue their education. The article discusses the Puthumai Penn Scheme, including its aims, relevance, and advantages. We will also discuss the key features of this plan.

Pudhumai Penn Scheme Benefits

The Pudhumai Penn Scheme is different from other schemes since it focuses on providing financial assistance, encouraging female students to continue their education, and discouraging parents and guardians from allowing their daughters to be married at a young age. Because of the foresight to focus on contemporary circumstances, the Puthumai Penn Scheme is going to usher in a new era of innovation within the next several years. A monetary award of Rs 1,000 per month will be provided to female students who are pursuing an education till they have either graduated or earned a certificate or diploma, irrespective of the field. Because it is common knowledge that female students in our country are discouraged from pursuing an education, this program offers a boost to the confidence of young women. The scheme aims to help 6 lakh females per year and has been budgeted at Rs 698 crore. Under Pudhumai Penn, money would be immediately paid to student bank accounts to assure their education. This means there will be no mediator in receiving money, just the children and the bank. The plan discourages child marriages and empowers women. They shouldn't accept anything that hurts their pride. Debit cards were given out to a total of 613 students during the initial phase of the plan. Talking about the initial stage of the scheme, this will be beneficial to around 6,500 students in the Tiruchi district who are now enrolled in institutions of the arts, sciences, and engineering.

Kalaignar Magalir Urimai Thogai Scheme

The Tamil Nadu government has identified 1.06 crore women, as eligible to benefit from the Kalaignar Magalir Urimai Thogai (women's basic income) scheme, which Chief Minister M.K. Stalin is set to launch in Kancheepuram on September 15, the birth anniversary of former CM. C.N. Annadurai. The Chief Minister M.K. During his speech at a meeting he chaired at the Secretariat in Chennai to review the arrangements being made towards the launch, Mr. Stalin said a total of 1.63 crore applications were received, of which 1,06,50,000 have been short-listed to benefit from the scheme. ATM cards would be issued in certain numbers initially, and will have to be issued to all. Though the Tamil Nadu government in its budget for 2023-24 stated that a sum of ₹7,000 crore has been allocated for this scheme, it is believed that the scheme will cost more. The CM on Monday said that a total sum of ₹12,000 crore would be allocated for this scheme annually. A senior official told *The Hindu* that the allocation of ₹12,000 crore would not be for the ongoing year, as a few months have already passed before the formal launching of the scheme on September 15. The CM advised officials to ensure that there were no faults anywhere while implementing the scheme.

Zero Ticket Bus Travel Scheme for Women

In May 2021, the Government of Tamil Nadu announced a scheme whereby women travelers can travel without paying any fare in government run normal-fare buses (for short distances up to 30 kilometers) in cities and towns in the state. Women are issued zero-tickets (a fare less ticket) when they travel in these buses. Free travel facilities have been provided for all women including working women, Transgender and girls who are pursuing higher education in ordinary fare city buses operated under the control of the Tamil Nadu State Transport Corporation since 2021.

Tamil Nadu Government announces and implements lots of scheme for the welfare of people of Tamil Nadu. One of the social welfare schemes for Tamil Nadu Women is Zero Ticket Bus Travel Scheme. It was announced and launched in the year 2021. The main objective behind launching Zero Ticket Bus Travel Scheme is to encourage women of Tamil Nadu for higher work participation and reduce the dependency on private mobility. Most of the Working Women, Girls Students and Women Labourers doesn't have their own convenience to commute one place to another. They regularly pay for travelling fare which overburden them financially. So to unburden the Women of Tamil Nadu financially, Government came up with a idea to provide free of cost travel in government run buses. Under Tamil Nadu Zero Ticket Bus Travel Scheme, No women have to any fare if they are travelling in Government of Tamil Nadu run buses. Zero Fare Ticket will be issued to women beneficiary at the time of travelling. Free of cost travel in government run buses will only valid up to 30 kilometers. Women Beneficiary has to carry one photographed identity card for verification purpose. Transgenders are also eligible for free of cost travel under Zero Ticket Bus Travel Scheme of Tamil Nadu. Free of Cost Bus Service will only provided in Tamil Nadu Government run Ordinary/ City Buses or Buses operated under the

control of Tamil Nadu State Transport Corporation. There is no need to apply anywhere to avail the benefit of free of cost travel in buses. Women Beneficiary can directly travel free of cost under Zero Ticket Bus Travel Scheme for Women of Government of Tamil Nadu.

Conclusion

The socio-economic conditions of the people can be improved through the efforts as well as supports of the government. Tamil Nadu State Government through offering different types freebie schemes provides employment opportunities to the people, reduces unemployment problems, generates income , alleviates poverty, contributes to industrial production, country's GDP, market share, export earnings, develops entrepreneurship, utilizes the available natural and human resources, provides food security, removes the disequilibrium among the people, reduces social evils empowers rural women and thereby strengthen rural economy.
